




NWEA Spark Community Web Site

Though this design may not seem extremely groundbreaking, it was actually pushing the envelope of Amazon's style guide. In fact you might say it is the start of the re-writing of their style guide. Historically, Amazon has tenaciously clung to an oversimplified visual style and format to avoid any issues with outdated customer hardware. Since the target market shopping at Amazon's digital properties were a little more up-to-date, we were allowed a little more freedom.

Our marketing solutions were well received both inside and outside the company, and many of Amazon's stores started using portions of our newly designed storefront.






Local.com Site Redesign – Business Page

We re-architected nearly every part of this site. Added a ton of new features such as new search functionality, city-based coupons, and event pages.




Amazon.com Order from Multiple Sellers

This mockup shows an option for showing payment and address info, in addition to showing the multiple items you are about to purchase and who they will be shipped from.






Altus Networks Network At-a-Glance Dashboard

I was called in to help launch a new site for a new network security product.


This is an early mockup of dashboard that let the user quickly gauge the health of their network and switch status.

This mockp shows an overview of the products you have installed, whether they have been activated, and the features you have enabled.




SumTotal Curriculum Creator




Amazon.com Creating a New Collating Window

This mockup shows amazon.com's new touchscreen method for entering the arrival date and time of a package that has arrived without the appropriate documentation.




Amazon.com Handheld Barcode Scanner Tools

Interaction Maps:



This work is done prior to wireframing and mockup generation. Creating a comprehensive interaction map before moving forward with other design details can save you from exploring ideas that just cannot work.

This interaction map shows a nightmare process that amazon.com wanted to automate. They wanted to remove the account managers they employed to help merchants get set up to sell. This interaction map showed the pain-points and time delays inherent in their system.


I made a second interaction map as a follow up to this that showed a simplified path, which we followed to create a true selfservice solution.
